Sub: Notification of Amendment to BSNL Executives Promotion Policy & Recruitment Rules 2018 (CPSU Cadre Hierarchy) approved by the BSNL Board on 28.05.2018 immediately. Further delay beyond 28.06.2018 will cause irreparable damage to the career prospects of more than 25,000 Executives due for promotion as per the new policy by another half an year who are the beneficiaries:

Respected Sir,

In continuation of the letter under reference above, we would like to submit the following facts also to the BSNL management.

- 1. More than 25,000 Executives are eligible for promotion as per the new promotion policy as on date of notification of the policy.
- 2. If the notification is delayed beyond this month, all will miss their opportunity to get the promotion before 01.07.2018.
- 3. Consequently all their subsequent promotions also will be delayed by another half an year. This will result in losing some promotions also in the future. Hereafter the effective date of promotions will be either 01^{st} July or 01^{st} January. Those who are eligible for promotion between 01^{st} January to 30^{th} June will be getting promotion on 01^{st} July and those who are eligible for promotion from 01^{st} July to 31^{st} December will be getting promotion from 01^{st} January of the next year and so on.
- 4. It is learnt that notification is delaying to give promotions to few thousand Executives, by upgrading the posts as per the existing RRs where as more than 70% of the Executives eligible for promotion as per the new promotion policy will be outside the purview of that promotion.
- 5. Even in the JTO to SDE promotion where deadlock situation is created by the Hon Ernakulam HC order, nothing can be done in the near future. They also have to suffer for others.

So any delay in notification of the new promotion policy will be detrimental to the interest of the Executives. Further it is also requested that no more disparity should be created in the promotion avenues between various cadres in different streams.
