Sub: Officiating promotions in Kerala Circle

Please refer to the letter under reference wherein this Association has categorically expressed its views on the above subject and urged the Circle Management, to, take stock of the situation in its real perspective and refrain from any hostile attempts to damage the meager career prospects of the Executives. In spite of our request to issue officiating promotion orders against all vacant posts as per the existing rule up to 179 days no action seems to have taken by the Circle Administration.

The CEC meeting of SNEA Kerala circle held at Trivandrum on 10&11 th Jan 2012 unanimously resolved to urge the Circle Administration to restore the normalcy in the matter by issuing the promotion orders for 179 days against the vacant posts in all cadres. The CEC meeting noted that while BSNL management is offering higher post and higher pay to the non opted ITS officers the Circle administration is acting with vengeance against the executives by reverting them from the post to which they are holding for last so many years without any financial benefits. The CEC meeting also decided to resort suitable trade union action if the demands are not met by the Circle Administration.

It is once again urged the administration to refrain from actions with vengeance to the executives and restore normalcy in the matter. We hope the administration will correct its orders by revising them to 179 days as provided under the rules and avoid any kind of industrial unrest in the best interest of service.
